9:15 AM

Past General Grand High Priests James AL Myers-S.C. reported on the affairs of the Foundation. He highlighted the page he had placed in the Souvenir Journal. It is a Donation Letter where Companions can fill out and make their donations and have record for their tax purposes. Also this letter can be used to solicit donations from the public.

9:25 AM

The Medical Team consisting of Heroine Gloria Smith-MD and Joyce Williams-N.C. reported on the cases they handle this year so far. As usual, they had a high number of hypertension cases. They believe that the delegates are not taking their medicine properly or leaving them home or not eating properly. All this leads to hypertension. They encourage all to always be properly

9:40 AM

General Grand Coordinator Willie Tate-TX gave his report. (See attached report) it was moved in properly second that report be received for information. Motion carried!

He also gave the Time and Place report as follows:

Parking is charged and you can make reservations beginning August 15, 2015. (See report) the year 2017 is open however the Royal Arch next year is 2017 and 2018.

It was moved in properly second that report be received motion carried.

10:00 AM

The Executive Committee on Honors reported that the committee approved the Honors for Freddie Pete-Ky., Gregory Harrison-TX, and Rudy A. Baker, VA. The committee also approved Harrison Gregory-TX but because he had to leave and what is not present to receive the presentation and explanation of the Jewel he would have to receive it makes year if he is present. The committee also recommended that the fee for Honors be raised to five hundred dollars and that no one will receive the Honors unless they are present. The report was received positively.

In the report Bishop Rodney McFarland was found not eligible to receive the Honors of Past General Grand High Priests. Our bylaws require that a person must have served as Most Excellent Grand High Priests or have received the Honors of Past Grand High Priests. Because Companion McFarland has not received those Honors in his home jurisdiction he was therefore not eligible for Honors in the General Conference. General Grand High Priests John White informed us that companion McFarland who is from the Louisiana jurisdiction have received Honors from to other jurisdictions. Therefore he should be eligible to receive the Honors here in the conference. He then moved that because of the situation Bishop McFarland received the Honors. and other jurisdictions does not carry any weight. Then after further discussion the members present decided to give Bishop McFarland the Honors of Past General Grand High Priests.

General Grand Secretary James E Alston read the rollcall of decease Companions during the ceremony.

The discussion on the Past Masters ritual continued and after much discussion it was moved by Most Excellent Grand High Priests James Hubbard-OK and seconded by many that the book be printed assigned the value and made available for sale to the Grand Masters.

11:35 AM

The delegation of Heroines of Jericho were finally received and after exchange of pleasantries the general Grand High Priests called off for lunch to resume at 1:10 PM.

2:50 PM

Tillers were appointed namely Adrian Robinson-DC Uril Johnson-BA and Terrence Cartwright-BA. Because MEGHP Gregory Benard declining the nomination for Treasurer that position was un-opposed.
