Lewis KYCH, Grand High Priest of all Capitular Masonry, do hereby proclaim the **13th York Rite Workshop**, will convene for all Holy Royal Arch Masons on Friday, January 6th and conclude on Saturday, January 7th, 2023 at the Sheraton Orlando North, 600 N Lake Destiny Rd, Maitland, FL.

LODGING ACCOMMODATIONS

The host hotel for this event is the Sheraton Orlando North located at 600 N Lake Destiny Rd, Maitland, FL 32751. The hotel can be reached at (407) 660-9000 to make your reservations. This will be strictly enforced. Please understand that it should not be expected that the local HOJ Court will pay your registration for you.

The focus of this year's Jewel Contest will be performing the ritualistic chapter closing. All rules and regulations for the Jewel Contest will be attached to the Proclamation. There will be prizes for first, second, and third place winners.

STATEWIDE EXALTATION

The statewide exaltation will be conducted on Friday, January 6, 2023 at 5:00pm. There will be no dispensation granted for local exaltations. Candidates are required to be present for a mandatory proficiency test on Friday, January 6, 2023 at 4:00 pm. Candidates not present for proficiency will not be permitted to participate in the statewide exaltation.

All Candidates are required to register at the regular rate of \$100.00, which can be submitted along with the local chapter registration.

ROYAL EXTRAVAGANZA GALA

The Most Excellent Union Grand Chapter HRAM and the Most Ancient Union Grand Court HOJ will have their "Royal Extravaganza Gala" on Saturday, January 7, 2023 at 7:30 PM. <u>This is a formal event</u>; therefore, tuxedos and tails are in order with collar (no crown, no apron). There will be several

presentations made during this event including awards and recognitions for Companions and Chapters around the Jurisdiction. All newly exalted Companions will also be recognized and receive all of their membership items during this event. HRAM and HOJ will take this time to show the full beauty and pageantry that masonry has to offer.
