PHA., will convene in Louisville, Kentucky on Friday, June 30 - Tuesday, July 4, 2023. COVID-19 Administrative Notes

The General Conference of Grand Chapters Holy Royal Arch Masons, PHA, U.S.A. & Bahamas, is fully aware and takes seriously the dangers involving exposure to the COVID-19 virus and its several variants. The protection and safety of our members, attendees, leadership, and staff is our top priority. All attendees will adhere to the following health and safety protocols during the assembly in Louisville, Kentucky.

1. The wearing of a facemask is REQUIRED at all times during the Annual Grand Convocation (unless actively eating or drinking). Facemasks and hand sanitizer will be made available to all members if needed.

2. Prior to checking in at the advance/on-site registration desk, you must first visit the Medical/COVID-19 Check-In station. Please DO NOT GO to the advance/on-site registration desk before going to the Medical/COVID-19 Check-In station.

3. The General Conference of Grand Chapters Holy Royal Arch Masons, PHA, U.S.A. & Bahamas is requiring all attendees to provide proof of one of the following: Vaccination card showing full vaccination status against COVID-19 or a Negative COVID-19 PCR or rapid test result, administered by a medical professional and taken within 72 hours of check-in at the 64 Annual Conference.

4. Daily screening will consist of a current COVID-19 Self-Assessment Questionnaire with a temperature check. Attendees with temperatures above 100.4° F / 38° C will be evaluated for COVID-19 and will not be allowed into the meeting. All attendees will

be required to complete a copy of the COVID-19 Liability Waiver and Statement of Understanding. If you answer "YES" to any of the "Symptoms", "Contact", or "Temperature" related questions on the COVID-19 Self-Assessment Questionnaire, you will not be permitted into the meeting and will need a negative COVID-19 test and normal temperature to be admitted the following day. A wristband will be issued to all attendees (daily) after successful completion of the medical screening process. NO WRISTBAND, NO ENTRY!!! A wristband is also required to register onsite or to pick up credentials at the advance/onsite registration desk.

5. Temperature checks will be required anytime you leave and return to any of the designated meeting areas. Temperature checks may also be rendered throughout the session or as directed by the presiding officer.

6 Social distancing inside and outside of the meeting is required. We are currently working with the venue to establish parameters around seating inside each meeting space. Please remain cognitive of your surroundings and environment as you enter the meeting rooms. 
